



ASC IN-PERSON EVENT GUIDELINES

The health and safety of everyone in attendance at American Spirit Championships is of utmost importance to us. ASC will be following all CDC, state, federal and venue-specific guidelines. Being that COVID restrictions and regulations may vary by state, city and facility, we have come up with options for ASC in-person events. ASC will announce which option we plan to implement per event 2 weeks prior to the event with our tentative schedule. Event guidelines are subject to change.

Guidelines for all in-person events for the time being are as follows:

- Athletes, coaches and spectators over the age of 5 will be required to wear a mask to enter the facility. Athletes will be able to take off their masks while warming up and competing. Spectators will be asked to keep masks on while inside of the facility.
- Social distancing will be implemented. Spectators must remain 6 feet apart – with exception to immediate family members.
- ASC will have sanitizing stations all throughout the facility – specifically at the entrance, merchandise, registration/check-in, practice room, and backstage. Athletes will be asked to sanitize before entering the warm up area and before performing on the main floor. We will have staff in charge of sanitizing in those specific areas.
- We will offer non-building in all divisions.
- Score sheets will be emailed only. Each program will be asked to give one email address for ASC to send all team scoresheets from the program to the email provided.
- Awards will follow shortly after the final performance of the session or the day.

Once the last team from each program is finished performing, the teams, coaches and spectators will be asked to exit the facility. The next program will have an allotted time to enter and exit the facility, and so on. • ASC will clear the facility to sanitize between each program's session. • Awards will be streamed live online.
